Subject:- Detailing Government witnesses in Trap Cases conducted
by Vigilance Bureau, Punjab.

Sir,

I has been informed by the Chief Director, Vigilance Bureau that whenever a trap is to be laid to nab an official in corruption case, concerned Deputy Commissioner is approached for detailing the witnesses. Many a time, Deputy Commissioner is not readily available and some-times the information leaks and trap fails.

After careful consideration of this matter, it is intimated that in the case of non-availability of the Deputy Commissioner, Additional Deputy Commissioner shall do the needful. It is also clarified that while detailing witnesses Deputy Commissioner/Additional Deputy Commissioner should only need to know whether the official under trap is group-A, B, or C and should detail witnesses accordingly. They are advised, not to ask for the department, Office or other details of the official under trap.
