Subject- Increase of Electricity Duty from 13% to 15% in Rural Areas.

In pursuance of the decision taken by the Council of Ministers in their meeting dated 13.3.2018 and in exercise of the Powers conferred by sub-section(1) of Section 3 of the Punjab Electricity (Duty) Act, 2005 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to enhance the rate of electricity duty by 2% from 13% to 15% ad-valorem (tariff) in the rural areas with effect from 1st April, 2018 on the Electricity supplied to all category of Consumers by the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited. As such electricity duty shall be 13% and 15% ad-valorem (tariff) in urban and rural areas respectively.

2. The entire amount shall be deposited in the "Head 0043-Taxes & Duties on Electricity-101-Taxes on consumption and sale of Electricity."

3. This notification supersedes the notification issued vide no. 13/18/2004-PE5/1546 dated 25-05-2010.

In supersession of the Government of Punjab, Department of Power (Energy Branch) Notification No.13/18/ 2004/PE5/1550 dated 25.5.2010 and in exercise of powers conferred by sub section (1) of section 3 of the Punjab Electricity (Duty) Act, 2005(Punjab Act No. 9 of 2005) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to levy the Electricity Duty on the electricity generated by the Captive Generating Plants installed within the meaning of Section 2(8), Section 9 of The Electricity Act, 2003 (36 of 2003) and Rule 3 of The Electricity Rules, 2005 as follows:-

- i) No Electricity Duty shall be levied on the electricity consumed by the owner(s) of such Plant(s) which qualify as Captive Generating Plant as per the provisions of the Rule 3 of the Electricity Rules, 2005.
- ii) Electricity Duty at the rate as applicable from time to time shall be levied on the electricity supplied by such Captive Generating Plant(s) to the consumer(s) other than that of the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited. The rates of tariff for levy of Electricity Duty in such cases shall be the rates as approved by PSERC from time to time for that category of consumers to whom the energy is being supplied.

It is clarified that No Electricity Duty shall be leviable on the electricity sold by such captive power plant outside the State through open access. Similarly no electricity duty shall be leviable on the electricity consumed within the State of Punjab from a captive power plant situated outside the State of Punjab.

For the purpose of computation of power, the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited shall install, erect and maintain a meter of the accuracy as defined in Regulation 8 of The Central Electricity Authority (Installation and Operation of Meters) Regulations,2006, at the cost of the owner of the Captive Generating Plant.

The owner of the Generating Plants shall maintain the record of the electricity generated/traded in the form of Annexure II and III as attached to Rule 17 of Punjab Electricity (Duty) Rules, 1958 and the record shall be open to the Electrical Inspector/Inspecting Officer for scrutiny at any time. The



record so maintained shall be checked/audited once in three months by the Inspecting Officer.

The Punjab State Power Corporation Limited shall collect the Electricity Duty and deposit the same in State Government Treasury by the 20th of the following month in accordance with the Rule 9 of Punjab Electricity (Duty) Rules, 1958.

The provisions of Punjab Electricity (Duty) Act, 2005 (Punjab Act No. 9 of 2005) and Punjab Electricity (Duty) Rules, 1958 shall be applicable on such transactions.
